SUMMARY

Follow welding procedures and able to carry out designated welding classification as described in the weld manual provided by Tricor. Develop/follow layout procedures.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Joining, surfacing or otherwise fabricating or repairing structures or parts of specialty metal, specialty metal equipment, or other weldable material. Follow welding procedures as outlined in weld training courses. Must follow all safety procedures regarding argon usage, moving material, etc. May include but not limited to laying out metal stock, indicating location, dimensions and tolerances for further processing, reading blue prints, sketches, models or other specifications.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. The employee must pass a weld training course. Failure to pass weld training course will result in dismissal from Tricor.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE
